NCBMF kicks off May 10th with a Friday Night Jam when the gates open at 4:30 PM. Friday evening's lineup includes Donna the Buffalo, Fireside Collective, and Dangermuffin. On Saturday the Festival gates open at 11:30 AM with Beer Tasting from 12:45 – 4:00 PM. Saturday's music line-up is headlined by Grammy award winners The Infamous Stringdusters, and also includes Scythian, River Whyless, Leon Majcen, Carly Burruss, Revelwood Mission Elonzo Wesley, Fireside Collective, and Cicada Rhythm. Please note: Tasting will only take place on Saturday. Friday night is sales only.

The ENO Hammock Lounge as well as food and merchandise vendors will be open. Beer can be purchased throughout the day at several locations, even during tasting hours. Official NCBMF merchandise and products sold by the bands will be available for purchase.

A Tasting Ticket includes admission to the show, a program guide, exclusive tasting glass and the right to try as many beers as you would like, for free, during the 3+ hour tasting session. Try new flavors and varieties, and find new favorites! A Music Only Ticket includes a program guide and admission to the festival. A Music Only Ticket does not include the tasting portion of the festival, but beer/wine/cider from several locations will be available for purchase throughout the day. A Designated Driver Ticket includes a program guide and admission to the festival. Designated Driver Ticket holders are not allowed to taste or purchase alcohol from any location throughout the day.
